Adelynrood is a retreat and conference center owned and operated by the Society of the Companions of the Holy Cross (SCHC) since 1914. The SCHC is composed of approximately eight hundred women, members of the Episcopal Church and the wider Anglican Communion, called to live individual lives under a rule of intercessory prayer, thanksgiving, and simplicity of life. Companions pray and act with intentional concern for three themes: the unity of all God's people, God's mission in the world, and social justice.

Companion membership is open to lay and ordained women affiliated with the Episcopal Church, or denominations with which the church is in formal communion, who are interested in exploring a call to the SCHC.
